School Admissions Policy

Policy: To work with parents and associated primary schools to make the application and transition phase as smooth as possible.

- Admissions to Year 7 are granted on the basis of Entrance Exam results
- Admission to Year 8, 9, 10 and 11 are based on 'reports obtained' from previous schools attended

Practice:

- Head teacher and Office Manager will participate in primary liaison process
- Entrance exams will be conducted in Maths and English for pupils seeking admission in Year 7
- Papers will be marked and the Head Teacher will notify parents on the success of the application
- Students seeking admission for Year 8, 9, 10 and 11 will submit a report for attendance, behaviour and progress from the previous school.

Monitoring:

- the Head Teacher and the Office Manager will carefully monitor the admission numbers each year
- the Head Teacher will monitor the number and content of parental contact during the applications phase
